Dear Summer School Students and Parents

Concordia High School will be offering summer school for students who are entering the 7th and 8th grade in the 2020-2021 school year.

Each day begins at 8:00 am and ends at noon. Students should report to the gym on arrival. If your student is arriving by car, please enter through the front from the driveway. Walkers may enter through the front entrance. The west doors are for bus riders only.

Students will be dismissed each day through the front entrance. The East hallways and classrooms will be undergoing a good cleaning. Bus riders and car riders will be dismissed at noon. If you are picking up your student by car, please follow the line through the drive down the sidewalk stopping at the cones please. If you have a change of plans about how your student will get home, please call the school by 11:30 am. Otherwise, the student will go home by the method you indicated on the enrollment form. Remember, there will be no food service offered at Summer School.

Transportation is available from Aullville, Ernestville, Emma, Metro East, St. Louis Street, and Orange Street. The schedule for the stops is as follows:
